Ibiza



Located in the Mediterranean sea, known as the clubbing capital of the world, Ibiza might seem like a whole country in miniature. It is an island of stunning natural beauty where you can lose yourself, find the best places of earth to watch the sunset, or hear the best DJs in the world.

Let's start with the top 3 places



Dalt Vila

A place where the sea meets the acropolis, and the locals have integrated their life with Dalt Vila's fortifications, guarded by its Renaissance walls which have been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

You will enjoy the history accumulated in this place and can also find magnificent views of the harbour and the beach from the top of the castle.

Let's start with the top 3 places



Es Cubells

One of the smallest towns in the island, with a particular charm that delights you from the moment you get there. Located at the edge of a cliff, it is filled with fishing coves surrounded by different stunning inlets.

It's a departure point for those who want to discover other nearby islands, or to find a lost paradise by the sea.

Let's start with the top 3 places



Cova de Can Marca

A beautiful natural cove in the northern part of the island, where you can enjoy the wonderful views of the seas and visit a cave that is over 100,000 years old, inside the cliff of the Port of Sant Miquel.

A place filled with stalagmites and stalactites that guide you to a waterfall. It is one of the most important touristic places in Ibiza.

Let's meet the best beaches in Ibiza



Cala Salada

Surrounded by nature, this cove has barely been urbanised and it's one of the most visited in Ibiza. The golden sand and blue, crystal clear waters will make your mind and body feel another level of relaxation.

It has a sister called Saladeta; you can get there on foot via a path on a small cliff, it's a less crowded beach but every bit as beautiful as its neighbour.

Cala Conta

The colour of the sea is turquoise in this cove. It is one of the must-visit places in Ibiza because it offers an idyllic view making you feel as if you are in paradise. Many of its visitors go to discover the treasures hidden in the sea with snorkels.

In summer it is filled with people, but you feel the Ibiza vibes once you put your feet on the sand and lose yourself in the transparent waters.
