Major toll roads in Spain



- ☐ Driving in Spain is a great way to get around, but you should remember that in Spain many major roads have tolls **that you have to pay.**
- ☐ On maps and road signs, a toll road is marked by the presence of the letter P in the road name. For example: A-33 is a free road, but **AP-34 is a toll road.**
- ☐ **The toll roads in Spain are located:** around Madrid, along the Mediterranean coast, the route from Bilbao to Barcelona, and around the cities of Malaga Leon, Pamplona, Seville and Santiago.

Things you need to have in your car



Under Spanish law, you must carry the following items in your car when driving in Spain. If not you will face a huge **penalty fine**.

- ☐ A spare pair of light bulbs.
- ☐ Documents – driving license, vehicle registration and insurance.
- ☐ Warning triangles (in case you break down).
- ☐ A spare pair of glasses (if the driver wears them).
- ☐ Warning vest (in case you have an accident).
